Training resources include;

QPR Training (Question, Persuade Refer) Call NM Suicide Prevention Coalition (NMSPC) at 505-315-4883 or Nancy Kirkpatrick at 505-222-8683 to arrange an in-person training. This is excellent for your whole staff. Many times, students will identify with, confide in, or open up to, a member of your staff easier than with a provider. As such, we recommend that all staff (receptionist, MA, nurse) also be trained. This is also important because the SBHC is not always open. Many trainers are available statewide for group training – course takes about 1 – 1 ½ hours. NMSPC adds the CALM (Counseling on Access to Lethal Means) to the end of the QPR training.

- NMSPC also offers **QPR Triage** for licensed BH providers at a very reasonable fee. (Please call for more information.)
- Training is also available for the staff of any government office

Kognito's At-Risk

All school teachers, staff and administrators (K-12) are offered At Risk, which is a free, one hour on-line training. Go to www.kognito.com/newmexico to take the training, or call Nancy Kirkpatrick at 505-222-8683 for more information. This is a basic course and would be appropriate for SBHC support staff. This does print a certificate of completion, but does not offer CME/CEUs.
